## 1 BE PREPARED

**Sign Up For AlertVI**  
Go to [www.vitema.vi.gov](http://www.vitema.vi.gov) to get earthquake and tsunami alerts via text or email.

**Know Your Risk**  
Take heavy objects off of high shelves, and secure furniture to walls.

**Check Your Home**  
Look for cracks in the foundation or other structural issues that could make your home or a room unsafe to be in during an earthquake.

## 2 MAKE A PLAN

**Practice Drills**  
Practice what to do during an earthquake with everyone in your household at least once a year.

**Know Your Emergency Contacts**  
Make a list of who to call after an earthquake to let them know you're safe. Keep the list short!

**Establish a Meeting Place**  
Pick a location outside of your home for family and loved ones to meet after a major earthquake.

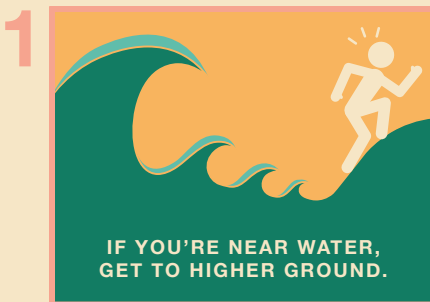
