Proof of Concept Technical Build FAQ

1. How did you select the winning contractor?

Through a rigorous RFP process, the NZDPU sought to identify a contractor to provide a technical execution team with strong engineering, data management, and product development capabilities to deliver a beta pilot of the data platform, in line with the recommendations of the CDSC.

All bids received were thoroughly considered over a months-long review process with a review team composed of NZDPU staff, representatives of the NZDPU Technical Advisory Board and independent reviewers, in rigorous multi-stage submissions and interview process. Each RFP bid was assessed against predefined objective criteria, and leading bids participated in multi-stage interviews.

The winning bidder, Insomniac Design, Inc. assembled a consortium that includes Google Public Sector, LLC and CyBourn. The Insomniac Design consortium demonstrated a clear understanding of the work required, a commitment to providing a bespoke solution in line with the recommendations of the CDSC, and deep organizational alignment with the objectives of the NZDPU.

2. What will each member of the winning consortium do for the NZDPU?

Insomniac Design, Inc. will lead the design, development, and launch of the beta pilot of NZDPU.

Google Public Sector, LLC will provide best in class cloud infrastructure and platform expertise to build a system that is equitably accessible and resilient for modern web platforms.

CyBourn, Inc. will provide security testing and verifications to protect the platform and the data it stores.

3. When will the NZDPU be delivered?

The NZDPU beta pilot is planned for launch at COP28.
