OUR MISSION

CollegePoint aims to Increase the number of high-achieving low- and moderate-income students who apply to and enroll in top colleges and universities nationwide.



THE CHALLENGE

Each year, tens of thousands of hardworking, high-achieving students from lowand moderate-income families fail to apply to leading colleges and universities that they are qualified to attend. What prevents high-achieving, low- and moderate-income students from applying to top-performing colleges and universities? They lack:

- 1. personalized guidance about which institutions are a good match given their level of academic achievement
- 2. accurate information about the real costs of leading institutions, and
- 3. models of other students like themselves who have successfully made the transition to our best colleges and universities.



OUR RESPONSE

In 2014, Bloomberg Philanthropies and America Achieves launched CollegePoint, a coalition of nonprofit organizations and philanthropic institutions with the goal of increasing the number of high-achieving, low- and moderate-income students enrolling in top colleges from 1/3 of 75,000 students then to more than 1/2 by 2020.

CollegePoint partners with four different college access organizations to provide high-achieving, low- and moderate- income students nation-wide with the individualized support they need to navigate the college application and financial aid process and, ultimately, enroll at an institution that matches their qualifications. Advisors use technology to connect with students virtually.




OUR RESPONSE

To date, **CollegePoint has served over 70,000 students**, and in 2020-2021, CollegePoint will serve over 10,000 students.

CollegePoint partners with respected national organizations, including ACT, College Advising Corps, College Board, College Possible, Jack Kent Cooke Foundation, Matriculate, ScholarMatch and uAspire to give these students personalized information on their college options and the associated costs, and, ultimately, to support high-achieving, low- and moderate-income students to apply to and enroll in top-performing colleges when they would not otherwise.¹

¹We define **top colleges** as schools that have a six-year graduation rate of 70% or higher and undergraduate enrollment of greater than 500 students. Currently, 319 institutions meet this criteria. The full list can be found at collegepoint.info/schools.

Identify Eligible Students





- An earned family income ≤ \$80,000 per year
- Partner with mission-aligned organizations such as ACT, the College Board, Jack Kent Cooke Foundation



Recruit Students

Reach out to students via diverse outreach channels, including phone calling, emails, SMS, digital ads and direct mail.



Engage Students

Each student receives a virtual advisor from one of our advising partners who provide students with the support they need to navigate the college application process



Assess and Improve

By working with researchers at UVA and Stanford we are able to continually improve advising for students



STUDENT OUTREACH

Through partnerships with the College Board and ACT, students learn about CollegePoint through three main channels:

- 1. Phone Calls
- 2. Email
- 3. Digital Advertising

CollegePoint reaches out to students in three cycles beginning in March of students' junior years through the end of September of their senior years. Examples of student outreach are included on the next few pages.







- Founded in 2005 at the University of Virginia;
 founding CollegePoint partner (2014)
- Mission: to increase the number of low-income, first-generation college, and underrepresented high school students who enter and complete higher education.
- CollegePoint advisors include 19 full-time
 eAdvisers based in Chapel Hill, NC
- Caseload per eAdvisor is ~ 165 students.

COLLEGE POSSIBLE MODEL

- Founded in 2000 in St. Paul, MN; founding CollegePoint partner (2014)
- Mission: to make college admission and success possible for students from low-income backgrounds through an intensive curriculum of coaching and support.
- CollegePoint advisors include 32 full-time
 AmeriCorps members (coaches) based in
 Portland, OR (12) and St. Paul, MN (14)
- Caseload per coach is ~ 165 students.







MATRICULATE MODEL

- Founded in 2015 in New York, NY; founding CollegePoint partner
- Mission: to empower high-achieving, low-income high school students to make the leap to our best colleges and universities
- CollegePoint advisors include over 800 college students (Advising Fellows) across 13 campus partners and 1 virtual fellowship
- Advising Fellows each serve ~4 students

SCHOLARMATCH MODEL

- Founded in 2010 in San Francisco, CA; joined
 CollegePoint initiative in 2016
- **Mission:** to make college possible for underserved youth by matching students with donors, resources, colleges, and professional networks.
- CollegePoint advisors include over 300 volunteer
 college coaches who range from 18 75 years old
 and live around the world.
- ScholarMatch Coaches each serve ~2 students.



LIFE CYCLE OF ADVISING

SPRING

- First wave of outreach to juniors
- Some advisors begin working with juniors
- College decisions for seniors

9 SUMMER

- Second and third waves of outreach to rising seniors
- Some advisors begin working with rising seniors
- Seniors transition to college

? FALL

- All advisors are working with seniors
- College Applications, essays and FAFSA

4 WINTER

- Advisors are working with students on finishing applications, applying for financial aid and finding scholarships.
- Advisors begin conversations around the transition to college


