This document is intended to be read in conjunction with the [Bloomberg US Corporate Index Methodology](#); these documents collectively constitute the index methodology for this Index.

The Bloomberg US Intermediate Corporate Index measures the investment grade, fixed-rate, US dollar-denominated securities issued by corporate issuers. The index includes publicly issued securities by industrial, utility, and financial issuers with at least USD 300mn amount outstanding. The index was created in April 2000, with history backfilled to January 1, 1973. The features specific to this Index are set out below.
