BCOM Handling of Market Disruption Event for LME Nickel

The London Metals Exchange (LME) suspended trading of the LME Nickel contract and announced the cancellation of recent trades. In accordance with the methodology, this constitutes a Market Disruption Event. Accordingly, the March roll for the Bloomberg Commodity Index (BCOM) will be held for this contract today under standard Market Disruption Events (MDE) handling rules. Under the standard rule, the roll period will not be extended as a result. Finally, in the absence of valid trading activity, the price determination for all LME Nickel contracts used in BCOM will be the official settlement prices as of March 7th, 2022.

While expecting orderly trading to return soon, we will be monitoring the situation closely in the coming days and stands ready to take adequate steps to ensure the Bloomberg Commodity Index (BCOM) remains a fully investable and replicable commodity benchmark.
