Bloomberg APA clients are responsible for submitting accurate trade reports to Bloomberg APA. If a client identifies an error in trade reports that they have sent to Bloomberg APA, the client is responsible for submitting any cancellations or amendments to trade reports to Bloomberg APA.

- 1. Clients should amend or cancel trade reports directly in their own system. Bloomberg APA will automatically publish the trade report with the appropriate cancellation or amendment flag.
- 2. In exceptional circumstances, when a client is suffering a technical outage in their own systems, or has lost the connection with Bloomberg APA, the client should contact Bloomberg Trade Desk.
- 3. From a charging perspective, Bloomberg APA treats each cancellation or amendment in the same manner as a new trade. No additional charges are applied.
